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7. Validity of offer: should be minimum 120 days from the date of opening of tender. The offer with a lower validity period other than 120 days will not be acceptable and such offer shall be ignored without assigning any reason.

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- 8. Earnest Money Deposit & Tender Cost: EMD for Rs. 11, 00,000.00 & Tender Cost for Rs. 3,000.00 has to be furnished as per clause No.25 of this tender .lf not submitted, your offer can be summarily rejected and no further correspondence shall be done.
- 9. Bidders to furnish audited balance sheet & profit-loss statement of last three financial years (2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17).

Pre-Qualifying Criteria:

1. Bidders must have executed one purchase order of at least 2.00 Crores or more than one purchase orders having total combined value of at least Rs. 2.00 Crores during the last five financial years (2012-13,2013-14,2014-15,2015-16,2016-17), for similar items of DSL system.

Orders value means basic order value in INR.

- 2. Firms should have supplied similar DSL items to any PSU Steel Plant /any Reputed Private Steel Plants.
- 3. Bidders must furnish self attested copies of such purchase orders.
- 4. Bidders have to submit proof of completion of supply against submitted Purchase Order copies for Sl. No. 2 & 3.

Method of submission of offer:

- 1. Quotation to be submitted in TWO BID System i.e.
- (a) <u>Techno commercial bid (Part I)</u>- This techno-commercial bid shall be conforming all technical specifications, commercial terms and conditions, EMD, Tender Cost & price format as per section-II with price column blanked (Un-priced) .
- **Price bid (Part II)** –This part shall comprise price format duly filled in.
 - 2. Techno-commercial bid should be sealed in separate envelope super scribing as part-I & Price bid should be sealed in a separate sealed envelope super scribing as part-II with tender enquiry reference, date, due date of opening & tenderer's name & address on each envelope.

Note: Bidder has to ensure that offer is submitted in TWO BID system as explained above & should indicate "TWO BID "on the top of cover envelope.



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3. Both bids i.e. part-I & part-II has to be sealed in **one sealed envelope** clearly super scribing on the top of envelope tender reference no. with date, due date of opening & tenderer's name & address on it. Bidder has to ensure that offer is strictly submitted in two bid system & must indicate "TWO BID" on the top of cover envelope & both the sealed covers must bear with the enquiry no. & date & due date of tender opening at its top.

Terms & Conditions:-

- 1. The offer has to be quoted exactly as per the detailed technical specification (Section-III).
- 2. Price: The rate quoted by the tenderer must be firm and the offers may remain valid for acceptance for 120 days from the due date of opening of the tender. Quotation erased or over written are likely to be rejected unless all corrections are authenticated with the tenderer's signature. Price bid format is based on the major supplies & activities but the firm shall be accountable & responsible for the completeness of the system as a whole and any item /Material /Activity which has not been covered by the Scope of work & supply of the specification shall be within the scope of the supplier, if it is required for the successful installation & commissioning in line with our approved Drawings & Bill of Material for which NO extra cost shall be payable.

2.1 FOR SUPPLIES:

Prices quoted must be firm till completion of work defined under the scope of supplier. The prices must be quoted as indicated in Section-II enclosed herewith.

2.2 Supervision of Erection at site:

- i) For making payment to the manpower, firm has to take care of all applicable taxes, levies, expenses towards various statutory and regulatory body and insurance coverage.
- **ii)** GST for supervision of erection, if applicable shall be reimbursed against documentary evidence by PURCHASER. The price also includes all charges towards to and fro travel, boarding, local transportation, medical etc.
- **iii)** Price shall remain firm and binding and shall not be subject to any variation whatsoever on any account except for statutory variation on taxes (GST).
- iv) Purchaser will not entertain any additional visit charges under following circumstances:
 - a) In case of delay in supervision of erection at site due to delay by supplier's engineer.
 - **b)** Due to lack of proper documents / knowledge to be possessed by supplier's engineer.
 - c) In case of additional visit necessitated due to fault / repair in the supplier's supplied equipment, because of design / manufacturing / workmanship fault.
 - **d)** In case of delays / loss of time beyond purchaser's control.
 - e) In case of short supplies by the supplier.
- 3. Offer has to be quoted on FOR HMBP Stores, Ranchi basis. The rate quoted shall be inclusive of all packing & forwarding charges but exclusive of TAXES (GST).

Note: After receiving comments on drawings, revised drawing incorporating comments shall be submitted within maximum 2-3 working days until or unless there is some extraordinary situation. For submission of drawings to HEC and thereafter getting approval from MECON, It shall be the prime responsibility of the firm. HEC shall provide all sort of support.

11. PROGRESS REPORT:

Progress of delivery/inspection must be given to the concerned officer who has signed the purchase order, on the 15th and 30th of each month during currency of delivery period. In case delivery period is crossed by the supplier, firm has to take approval of buyer in writing before dispatch.

12. SUBLETTING AND ASSIGNMENT:

The supplier shall not, have without the previous consent in writing of the purchasers, sublet, transfer or assign the purchase order or any part thereof or interest therein or benefit or advantage thereof in any manner whatsoever. Provided nevertheless that any such consent shall not relieve the supplier from any obligation, duty or responsibility under the purchase order.

13. Inspection Clause: -

Inspection Shall be arranged by Sr DGM, I/c/QCA, HMBP/HEC or his representative(s), however, HEC reserves the right to inspect after receipt of material at HMBP and if it is not found confirming to our specification, the material shall be rejected and firm have to replace it at no extra cost and Inspection shall be done at per Clause No. 8 & 9 (Inspection & Tests) of Technical Specification of NIT (Section-III).



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14. The Price quoted by the tenderers should be exclusive of Taxes. The rate and nature of Tax applicable should be shown separately. Tax will be paid to the seller at the rate at which it is liable to be assessed or has actually been assessed on the date of supply provided the transaction of sale is legally liable to tax and within the delivery period. Any change on the taxes structure beyond the delivery period will not be considered by HEC.

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- **15.** Quotations erased or over written are likely to be rejected unless all corrections are authenticated with the tenderer's signature.
- **16.** Full particulars i.e. specification, literature and / or drawing wherever applicable has to be submitted along with the quotation. The brand and 'Make' name must be indicated.
- **17.** The Corporation does not pledge itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to itself the right of accepting the whole or any part of tender or portion of the quantity offered and you shall supply the same at the rate quoted.
- **18.** Order placed as a result of this tender will be subject to the Corporation's General Terms and Conditions of contract which can be down loaded from our website (www.hecltd.com).
- **19.** Corporation reserves the right to call for and examine at any time the books of accounts and other documents and papers of the firm for the purpose of ascertaining whether any excess payments has been made or the firm likely to be received / received undue benefit out of execution of the particular contract.
- **20.** The final quantity may vary at the time of finalization of tender; however the proper clarification / confirmation shall be taken from the firms.
- **21.** Delivery: The time for and the date of delivery of the Stores stipulated in the acceptance of tender shall be deemed to be the essence of the contract and delivery must be completed no later than the dates specified therein.
- **22.** Based on HEC's requirement and in order to ensure security of supply from more than one sources, the total tendered quantity of any item may be split amongst more than one successful bidder at L1 Landed price. Hence Purchase Order may be placed on more than one firms and the repeat order for 100% quantity may be placed on successful bidder with mutual consent.
- **23**. <u>LD & Risk Purchase Clause</u> If the material is not supplied with in the stipulated period then material can be procured at the risk & cost of the firm without giving any notice to the firm. Otherwise:
- a)The purchaser to recover from the contractor a sum of 0.5 % per week (completed week) of the price of the stores(up to maximum 10 %) as liquidated damages, which the contractor has failed to deliver as aforesaid or
- b) The purchaser may procure the undelivered stores / similar items from elsewhere, without notice to the contractor at the risk of the contractor without canceling the contract in respect of the consignment not yet due for delivery or,
- c) To cancel the contract or a portion thereof.
- **24.** There is no obligation on our part to accept delayed / late tenders. Tenders received after the due date of opening are liable to be summarily rejected.



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25. <u>Earnest Money & Tender Cost</u> - Earnest money Rs. 11, 00,000.00 & Tender Cost of Rs. 3,000.00 will have to be deposited by demand draft / bank guarantee from any nationalized bank Payable on the State Bank of India, Ranchi Hatia Branch, in favor of Heavy Engineering Corporation Ltd. Ranchi. - 4. EMD Should be submitted along with techno-commercial bid (Part – 1).

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Note: No EMD shall be required under the following cases:

- A. National Small Industries Corporation / Small Scale Industries / Micro, Small Scale industry (MSE), as per Government directive *.
- B. Firms registered with DGS&D for only those items if they are under this tender.
- **Security Deposit** Successful tenderer will have to deposit security deposit equal to 5% of the basic value of the contract within 21 days from the date of award of contract, failing this, the contract will be cancelled and the stores will be procured at the Risk and expenses of the contractor. This will be in addition to other remedies available to the purchaser for the successful completion of the contract as provided in general terms & conditions of the contract of HEC. The validity of the security deposit shall be up to the receipt of the last consignment.
- **27. Performance Bank Guarantee:** Successful bidder/s will have to deposit the performance bank guarantee as per HEC format for 10% of total order value from any nationalized bank to be valid till full guarantee/ Warranty period.
- **28. Genuineness of documents –** Firm shall be responsible for the genuineness of all the submitted documents/certificates and if any time these are found false/fabricated then firm shall be liable for punishment as per rules of the company and can be debarred from any further participation in any tender in HFC.
- **29. Guarantee Clause:** The tenderer shall stand guarantee for design, manufacturing and satisfactory performance of the equipment / items/ electrics for a period of 18 months after supply or 12 months from the date of issue of last FAC (Final acceptance test conducted by M/s VSP). During this period elimination of defect in the design, manufacture, material quality and replacement of defective parts shall be to the satisfaction of M/s VSP / MECON / HEC. Cost of dismantling, transport and refitting, if any, during the elimination of defects / replacement of defectives parts shall be fully borne by the successful tenderer without any price implication.
- 30. Law Governing contract-
- (1) This contract shall be governed by the laws of India for the being in force.
- (2)Irrespective of the place of delivery, the place of payment under the contract, the contract shall be deemed to have been made at the place from which the acceptance of tender has been issued.
- (3) Jurisdiction of Courts: The court of the place from where the acceptance of tender / purchase order has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in respect of the contract,
- (4) Marking of Stores: The marking of the stores must comply with the requirements of the laws relating to Merchandise Marks for the time being in force in India.

31. ARBITRATION

In the event of any dispute or difference of opinion between the Heavy Engineering Corporation or any of its units / division and the contractors as to the respective rights and obligation of the parties hereafter or to the true intent and meaning of these presents and the many articles of conditions thereto, such dispute of difference of opinion shall be referred to the many articles of conditions thereto, such dispute



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Dated: 13.01.2018 of difference of opinion shall be referred to the sole arbitration of the Chairman, Heavy Engineering Corporation and his decision shall be final, conclusive and binding on the parties.

32. Mode of dispatch:

By Road to the consignee at In-charge stores /HMBP/HEC Ltd. Ranchi. For the consignments dispatched by road, the supplier shall ensure that the following are observed by them:

- i) All dispatches must be affected only on receipt of written dispatch clearance from the purchaser.
- ii) Material shall be dispatched to In-charge stores/HMBP/HEC Ltd, Ranchi.
- iii) Care shall be taken to avoid damages during transit to ensure that all the packages are firmly secured.

33. PACKING, FORWARDING & SHIPMENT

- a. The supplier has to ensure proper packing so that material reaches destination without damage.
- b. The supplier shall notify the purchaser of the date of each shipment from his works and the expected date of arrival at the site for information.

INTEGRITY PACT

Between

Heavy Engineering Corporation Ltd.(HEC) hereinafter referred to as "Th Principal",	е
and

Preamble

In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint an Independent External Monitor (IEM), who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

Section 1 – Commitments of the Principal

- 1. The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:
 - a. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.



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b. The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential/ additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.

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- c. The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.
- 2. If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC/PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the Chief Vigilance Officer and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section 2 – Commitments of the Bidder(s) / contractor (s)

- 1. The Bidders(s) / Contractor (s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
 - a. The bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer promise or give to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material or other benefit which he/ she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
 - b. The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidders into any undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelisation in the bidding process.
 - c. The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not commit any offence under the relevant IPC/PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.



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d. The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the Agents/ representatives in India, if any. Similarly the Bidder(s) /Contractors(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principals, if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" (enclosed) shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s). Further, as mentioned in the Guidelines all the payments made to the Indian agent/ representative have to be in Indian Rupees only. Copy of "Guidelines on Indian Agents of Foreign Suppliers" attached.

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- e. The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- 2 The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3 – Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts If the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2, above or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility in question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder(s) / Contractors) from the tender process or take actions like Banning of business dealings etc.

Section 4 – Compensation for Damages

- (1) If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit / Bid Security.
- (2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages of the Contract value or the amount equivalent to Performance Bank guarantee.

Section 5 – Previous transgression



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(1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in any country conforming to the anti corruption approach or with any other Public Sector enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.

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(2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or action can be taken against the bidder.

Section 6 - Equal treatment of all Bidders / Contractors / Subcontractors

- (1) The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) undertake (s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact, and to submit it to the Principal before contract signing.
- (2) The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders, Contractors and Subcontractors.
- (3) The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this Pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7 – Criminal charges against violation by the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) / Subcontractor(s)

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to the Chief Vigilance Officer.

Section 8 – Independent External Monitor / Monitors

- (1) The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
- (2) The monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the CMD, HEC.
- (3) The Bidder(s) / Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all Project documentation of the Principal including that provided by



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- the Contractor. The Contractor will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to subcontractors. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s) / Contractor(s)/ Subcontractor(s) with confidentiality.
- (4) The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- (5) As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Bevond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerated action.
- (6)The Monitor will submit a written report to the CMD, HEC within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
